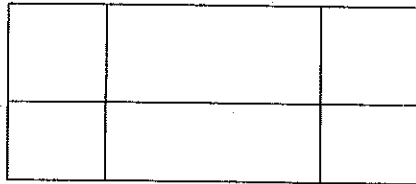
Step One: Pairwork

21 people get on.*



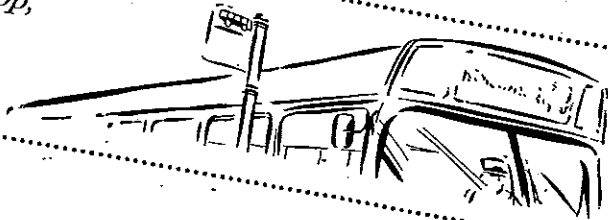
*At the last bus stop,
