1.	Before you do this trick, you have to get a straw. If you don't have a straw, a cigarette will work. You can also use a round pencil, but it is a little more difficult. (A				
	After she answers, say "Watch." With your right hand, make three circles around the straw clockwise. Move your hand slowly.				(B)
	After you've put the straw on the desk, say to your partner, "Did you know that your hands contain electricity?" She'll probably answer, "I know that." "I didn't know that." or "Really?"				(C)
-	As you move your hand away from the straw, secretly blow on it so it moves toward your hand.				(D)
